

ORDINANCE NO. 07-27

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES
FOR THE VILLAGE OF SOMONAUK, DEKALB AND LASALLE COUNTIES,
ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2007
AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2008**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF
SOMONAUK, DEKALB AND LASALLE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: That the sum \$379,250.00 Dollars be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon and against all property within the corporate limits of the Village of Somonauk, DeKalb and LaSalle Counties Illinois, subject to taxation, according to the valuation of said property as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the fiscal year of said Village of Somonauk commencing May 1, 2008 and ending April 30, 2008, which sum is to be applied in payment and satisfaction of the appropriation heretofore made by the Village of Somonauk in Ordinance No. 07-27, passed on the 13th day of December, 2007 by the Village Board of Somonauk, DeKalb and LaSalle Counties, Illinois, for all the various funds, agencies, and departments of the Village of Somonauk.

SECTION 2: That the sum \$379,250.00 Dollars is hereby levied and assessed for the following items in the amounts as indicated; that the total appropriation is designated under the columnar heading "Total Appropriation"; that the part or portion thereof to be raised from other sources or from taxes previously levied is set forth and described under the columnar heading "Amount to be Raised from other Sources or from Taxes Previously Levied"; and that the part or portion thereof to be raised by taxation is set forth and described under the columnar heading "Amount to be Raised by Taxation":

SECTION 3: FILING WITH THE COUNTY CLERK – that the Clerk of the Village of Somonauk shall file certified copies of the Ordinance with the County Clerk of DeKalb and LaSalle Counties, Illinois, within thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 4: REPEALER – All Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY – This Ordinance and every provision thereof, shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and provisions and parts of phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions and sections not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE – This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
